REQUIREMENTS

- **GENERAL:** Students must pass Permit Test on the "Rules of the Road" and vision screening to be able to receive permit to drive. Pay \$20.00 Permit fee. Pass both potions of Driver Education Classroom and BTW to be eligible to go get license. To be eligible, but does not guarantee, for Waiver (i.e. go to DMV with all correct forms and get picture taken to get license without taking road test) student must be receiving a grade of B or better in both phases of Driver Education.
- **CLASSROOM:** The State of Illinois requires 30 clock hours of attendance for instruction. Students will be told the number of allowable absences at the beginning of the semester by their teacher. The absences may be excused or unexcused. The student might be getting an A in class , but exceeds the number of allowable absences, he/she **will not** pass the classroom portion of Driver Education. Homework that is due or tests taken on a day where the absence is unexcused will not be made up per school rule.

BEHIND-THE-WHEEL:	The State of Illinois requires 6 clock hours of instruction and 6 hours of
	observation. Students will be told the number of allowable absences
at	
	the beginning of the semester by their teacher. The absences may be excused or unexcused. Forgetting your driving permit or glasses (B restriction on permit) is considered unexcused. The student might be a very good driver, but exceed the allowable number of absences,
he/she	
	will not pass the BTW portion of Driver Education. Forgetting driving permit or glasses (B restriction on permit) will be considered
unexcused.	
	Flip flops and open-heeled sandals will not be worn when driving BTW.

STUDENT: All school rules apply. **Students are expected to behave as young adults in class**

and BTW. A good attitude and maturity level are a vital part of safe and responsible driving. These need to be demonstrated to qualify for a driver's license. If the instructor deems the student is lacking in this area, parent contact will be made and possible removal from the program.
